CALL FOR ABSTRACTS NOW OPEN!

Deadline for submission **October 12, 2018** Space is limited – submit early to ensure space availability!

Call for Abstract Criteria:

Abstracts submitted must meet the following criteria for consideration:

- Length of abstract should not exceed 300 words
- Each registrant can submit only one abstract for evaluation
- Data and content should be recent (within the last 12 months)
- Abstracts and posters presented at this conference previously will not be accepted
- Posters must fall under one of the following Topics/Tracks for submission: Patient Safety, Evidence-Based Practice, Innovation, Improved Patient Outcomes, Research, Process Improvement, or Patient Experience

Abstracts submitted should follow the following format and include headings:

- Purpose
- Background / Significance
- Strategy / Implementation / Methods
- Evaluation / Outcomes / Results
- Conclusions / Implications for Practice

Abstracts submitted must include:

Title of Project, Name(s) of person(s) submitting abstract, Organization, City and State.

Individuals will be notified by October 26, 2018 of acceptance. Submissions will undergo team review and will be accepted on a “first come first serve” basis provided the abstract meets defined criteria (above).

Authors of abstracts accepted for presentation at the conference are required to:

- Respond with their intent by the designated date in the invitation.
- Register for the conference via LMS. **Failure to respond or register will cancel the presentation from the conference program.**
